5.	Wat Arun	Wat Arun Pier	<p>Know more about Wat Arun and how to go there in my article: https://preparetravelplans.com/wat-arun-bangkok-guide/</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take a BTS Skytrain to Saphan Taksin BTS Station and then go out the Exit 2. 2. From there, walk to the Sathorn Pier in 2 minutes. 3. At Sathorn Pier, take a Chao Phraya Express Boat (Orange Flag) to Tha Tien Pier. [15 Baht, 15 minutes] 4. Get off the boat at the Tha Chang Pier. 5. After that, take a cross-river ferry from there to Wat Arun. [4 Baht, 5 minutes]

8.	Mahanakhon SkyWalk	Chong Nonsi BTS Station (Exit 3)	<p><i>*Head for the Exit 3 of Chong Nonsi BTS Station which will provide direct access to the entrance of Mahanakhon Skywalk building.</i></p>
9.	Wat Pho	Tha Tien Pier/ Sanam Chai MRT Station (Exit 1)	<p>Know more about Wat Pho and how to go there in my article: https://preparetravelplans.com/wat-pho-bangkok-guide/</p> <p><i>*Option 1: By BTS and Chao Phraya Express Boat (Orange Flag)</i> <i>Saphan Taksin BTS Station (Exit 2) → Walk to Sathorn Pier → Take a Chao Phraya Express Boat (Orange Flag, 15 Baht, 15 minutes) to Tha Tien Pier → Walk to Wat Pho in 3 minutes</i></p> <p><i>*Option 2: By MRT</i> <i>Sanam Chai Station (Exit 1) → Walk to Wat Pho in 5 minutes.</i></p>

15.	Nanta Show in Bangkok	Victory Monument BTS Station (Exit 2)	<p>*From Victory Monument BTS Station, Exit 2 Walk around 9 minutes and you'll reach the place.</p>
16.	Chao Phraya Princess Cruise	Asiatique Pier	<p>Check the Chao Phraya Princess Cruise price here.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take a BTS Skytrain to Saphan Taksin BTS Station and then go out the Exit 2. 2. From there, walk to the Sathorn Pier in 2 minutes. 3. At Sathorn Pier, take an Asiatique Shuttle Boat to Asiatique Pier which is free. 4. You can get on the cruise at Asiatique Pier.

Rooftop Bar at Banyan Tree Bangkok	Lumphini MRT Station (Exit 2)/ Sala Daeng BTS Station (Exit 4)	<p>*Option 1: From Lumphini MRT Station (Exit 2) Walk around 8 minutes and you'll reach the place.</p> <p>*Option 2: From Sala Daeng BTS Station, Exit 4 Walk around 12 minutes and you'll reach the place.</p>

18.	Floating Markets i. Damnoen Saduak ii. 21.	Buffet in Baiyoke Sky Hotel	Ratchathewi BTS Station (Exit 4)	<p>Check the buffet price here.</p> <p>*From Ratchathewi BTS Station, Exit 4 <i>Walk around 15 minutes and you'll reach Baiyoke Sky Hotel.</i></p>

22.	Jim Thompson House	National Stadium BTS Station (Exit 1)	*From National Stadium BTS Station, Exit 1 Walk around 5 minutes and you'll reach the museum.

25.	Erawan Shrine	Chit Lom BTS Station (Exit 2)	*From Chit Lom BTS Station, Exit 2 Walk around 1 minute and you'll reach the shrine.
26.	Khao San Road	Phra Arthit Pier	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take a BTS Skytrain to Saphan Taksin BTS Station and then go out the Exit 2. 2. From there, walk to the Sathorn Pier in 2 minutes. 3. At Sathorn Pier, take a Chao Phraya Express Boat (Orange Flag) to Phra Arthit Pier. [15 Baht, 30 minutes] 4. Get off the boat at the Phra Arthit Pier. 5. After that, walk to the Khao San Road in 10 minutes.
27.	Muay Thai Live	Asiatique Pier	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take a BTS Skytrain to Saphan Taksin BTS Station and then go out the Exit 2. 2. From there, walk to the Sathorn Pier in 2 minutes. 3. At Sathorn Pier, take an Asiatique Shuttle Boat to Asiatique Pier which is free. 4. After you get off the boat at Asiatique Pier, walk to the Muay Thai Live centre in 4 minutes.
28.	Wat Traimit Withayaram	Hua Lamphong MRT Station (Exit 1)	*From Hua Lamphong MRT Station, Exit 1 Walk around 5 minutes and you'll reach the temple.

29.	Lumpini Park	Si Lom MRT Station (Exit 1)	<i>*Head for the Exit 1 of Si Lom MRT Station which will provide direct access to the Lumpini Park.</i>
30.	Siam Niramit Bangkok	Thailand Cultural Center MRT Station (Exit 1)	<i>*Go out the Exit 1 of the station and then take a free shuttle bus to Siam Niramit Bangkok. It runs every 15 minutes from 5:15 PM to 7:45 PM.</i>
