1. Haeundae Blueline Park Station

9:30 AM to 10:00 AM | 30 Minutes

Option 1:

 17 minutes' walk to Haeundae Blueline Park (Mipo Station) from Haeundae Beach. [See here for more info]

Option 2:

 Take the Metro Line 2 to Jung-dong Station. From there, you go out of Exit 7 and walk to Haeundae Blueline Park (Mipo Station) for about 15 minutes. [See here for more info]

2. Haedong Yonggungsa Temple



Option 1:

• Take the Bus Haeundae-gu No.10 from the bus stop of Cheongsapo to Daewoo apartment. From there, cross the road to the opposite bus stop and take the Bus No. 100 to Haedong Yonggungsa Temple. [See here for more infol

Option 2:

- Ride a taxi from Cheongsapo Station to Haedong Yonggungsa Temple. The taxi fare is around 10,000 won.

3. Oryukdo Skywalk

2:00 PM to 3:30 PM | 1.5 Hours

Take the Bus No. 181 from Haedong Yonggungsa Temple to Haeundae Station. At Haeundae Station, take the Metro Line 2 to Kyungsung Univ. Pukyong Nat'l Univ. Station. From there, you go out of Exit 5 and walk to the bus stop of Kyungsung University. Afterward, take the Bus No. 24 to Oryukdo Skywalk. [See here for more info]

Join this famous <u>Bus Tour 1</u> or <u>Bus Tour 2</u> in Busan. Both cover Haedong Yonggungsa Temple, Busan Skywalk, Gamcheon Culture Village and more!:)

• Take the Bus No. 131 from Oryukdo Skywalk to the bus stop of Kyungsung Univ. Pukyong Nat'l Univ. From there, you transfer to Bus No. 1003 and go to Busan aquarium (at Haeundae Beach). [See here for more info]

- Board the Metro Line 1 to Jagalchi Station. From there, you go out of Exit 1 and walk to the bus stop of Chungmu Market. Afterward, take the Bus Seogu 2-2 to Gamcheon Culture Village.

- Jagalchi Market, Gukje Market, Yongdusan Park, Gwangbokro Fashion Street and BIFF Square are all very close, you can visit all these places in one day. Check out the map here to get an idea.

6. BIFF Square & Nampodong Street

- (7) 6:30 PM to 9:00 PM | 2.5 Hours
- 1 minute' walk to BIFF Square from Gwangbokro Fashion Street.



Must try foods at BIFF Square: Ssiat Hotteok (Korean Sweet Pancake), Korean Fried Chicken, Korean Chicken Skewer, **Dinner** Grilled Scallop and Twist Ice Cream.

- Take the Metro Line 1 to Nampo Station. From there, you go out of Exit 1 and take the Bus No. 6, 26, 30, or 71 to Amnam Dongbu Community Center bus stop. From there, walk to the cable car station in 10 minutes.

 Walk from Songdo Cloud Trails to the bus stop of Amnam Dongbu Community Center. Then, take the Bus No. 6 or 71 to the bus stop near Exit 6 of Nampo Station. From there, walk to Lotte Department Store. [See here for more info]

4. Seomyeon

4:30 PM to 9:30 PM | 5 Hours

- Take the Metro Line 1 from Nampo Station to Seomyeon Station. Go to Exit 12 for direct access to the Seomyeon Underground Shopping Center.
